



## **Eluna Learns 2024 Ex Libris Knowledge Days and ELUNA 2024 Annual Meeting, Developers Day+, & Analytics Afternoon Preview Session Q & A**

**When will hotel registration open up with the ELUNA discount?**

Laura Morse: The hotel reservation link will be available in February and posted to the ELUNA 2024 Local Information page.

**Will there be any flexibility to attend Advanced Analytics if someone needed to leave ELUNA Annual Meeting on Thursday afternoon?**

Laura Morse: If you register for both Annual Meeting and Advanced Analytics you can attend. ELUNA does not offer single day registrations for Annual Meeting.

**When do you hope to have the full Annual Meeting program listing available online?**

Laura Morse: This should be available in early March 2024.

**This will be my first ELUNA conference. Are evenings generally open/free? There was mention of a Wednesday evening reception, but what about other evenings?**

Laura Morse: Evenings are generally free. The reception will be Wednesday evening.

**Is Developers Day+ and the Analytics afternoon at the same time?**

Laura Morse: Yes, Developers Day+ and Analytics Afternoon overlap on Tuesday evening.

**Will there be any Clarivate presentations during Developers Day+?**

Laura Morse: No, not this year.

**The Analytics Afternoon session overlaps with the Knowledge Days Or Developers Day+. Is it possible for someone to register for Knowledge Days and Analytics Afternoon, OR Developers Day+ and Analytics Afternoon. In either case, with the understanding that the Tuesday afternoon of Knowledge Days or Developers Day+ would not be attended in lieu of Analytics Afternoon?**

Laura Morse: Yes, someone can, but there are no discounts on registration for portions of Knowledge Days for Developers Day that would be missed for Analytics Afternoon.

**About Knowledge Days, do attendees have to stay in one track or can we jump between the Alma and Discovery tracks?**

Laura Morse: You can jump between tracks.

**Will there be many sessions for Summon users?**

Laura Morse: There will be some sessions of interest to Summon users at the Annual Meeting.

**For Knowledge Days, do attendees have to stick with one of the four tracks or can they attend sessions ala carte?**

Laura Morse: Attendees will choose sessions a la carte.

**Would you please restate the prerequisites for the best experience of Analytics Afternoon?**

Laura Morse:

- Attendees must have familiarity with basic report design in Oracle Analytics, and fundamental programming concepts like conditionals and data types.
- This session will not cover basic report design. Attendees should be experienced in the topics covered by sessions 01 -04 of Ex Libris' webinar series Alma Analytics: Become an Expert. If you are at the beginning of your Analytics journey, we suggest starting with the webinar series and consider attending Ex Libris Knowledge Days training sessions on Analytics before attending this event.
- Attendance will be capped at 50 participants, with a registration cost of \$100. Analytics Afternoon attendees must also attend the main ELUNA 2024 Annual Meeting. Please note that the Analytics Afternoon overlaps with a portion of Developers Day+.

**I am also a new Alma member. I want to participate in Knowledge Days. Should I plan my trip for May 13-14 primarily, or should I plan to stay longer? I guess I am asking if there is a reason I should plan to stay after the 14th.**

Laura Morse: Knowledge Days is hands on training from Ex Libris. The ELUNA Annual Meeting also offers a wide range of sessions that would be of interest to Alma libraries.
